What is Promise Pathways?

Promise Pathways is an after-school program for Birmingham City Schools' middle schoolers. By bringing local businesses into the after-school setting, students will gain exposure to careers in the community. Sessions will be engaging and allow students to interact with an aspect of the business that the business brings in to the program.

We create career exploration opportunities by connecting community partners with existing after school programs.

Middle schoolers participating in career exploration are more likely to enroll in high level courses and have higher self-esteem. (America's Promise Alliance, 2019)
