We invite you to help us identify our school's most compelling nominees for the Morehead-Cain, a prestigious scholarship at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. We ask that you do not discuss your recommendations with the students.

What is the Morehead-Cain?

The Morehead-Cain is the first merit scholarship program established in the United States, founded at the nation's first public university—the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. It is a unique, fully funded educational opportunity like no other. It includes room and board, a summer enrichment program offering global travel, research, and real-world work experiences, and a discovery fund for educational opportunities outside of the classroom.

What makes a Morehead-Cain Scholar?

There is a handful of dynamic leaders in every senior class that sets a higher standard for the rest—in character and achievement. They may be active in traditional activities such as student government and clubs, or they may have ventured out into new areas. In either case they have added to the positive spirit of our school and community—the senior class would be less active and engaged without them. It is from this elite group we hope to select our nominee.

Our Morehead-Cain nominee must demonstrate the following criteria:

- Leadership
- Moral Force of Character
- Scholarship
- Physical Vigor

The Morehead-Cain is merit-based; neither financial need nor a student's interest in attending UNC should be considered.
